Bubbles Dive Resort, Pulau Perhentian.

Bubbles Dive Resort is a small eco-resort tucked away in a quiet part of Perhentian Island.

With a turtle conservation team on site, the resort embraces eco-tourism and mindful island living.

At night, white lights are switched off to protect nesting turtles, allowing guests to experience natural darkness and beautiful starry skies.

Guests often feels like they are joining a community rather than being a customer.

How to get there?

By Plane

The nearest airport is **Sultan Ismail Petra Airport (KBR)** in Kota Bharu.

There are regular flights from Kuala Lumpur via:

- AirAsia
- Malaysia Airlines
- Batik Air
- Firefly



Flights usually depart from KLIA, KLIA2, or Subang Airport (SZB).

Airport pickup from Kota Bharu to Kuala Besut can be arranged if your flight details are shared in advance.

Recommended flight times based on ferry times:

Arrival:

11:00am ferry – book a flight that arrives before 9:30am

1:30pm ferry – book a flight that arrives before 12:00pm

Departure:

8:00am ferry – book a flight that departs after 12:00pm

12:00pm ferry – book a flight that departs after 4:00pm

How to get there?

By Bus

Several bus companies travel from Kuala Lumpur to Kuala Besut Bus Terminal, including:

- **Perdana Express**
- **Sani Express**
- **Queen Express**



Buses usually depart from Terminal Bersepadu Selatan (TBS) in Kuala Lumpur.

Travel time: 8-10 hours (overnight bus), normally best departure time would be between 11pm - 12am the night before.

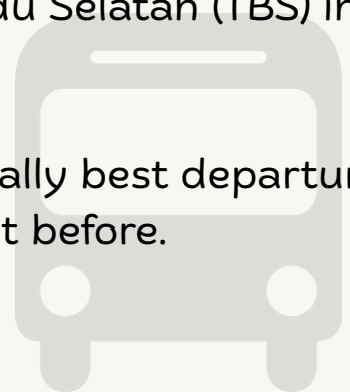
Estimated fare: around RM50 - 60 one way

Self Drive

Recommended Parking: **Safe Park Parking (4 mins walk to Jetty)**

How to get there?

At Kuala Besut Jetty

Head towards Bubbles meeting point at the jetty. It is at a shop with a “sandwich board” sign saying ‘Bubbles Dive Resort’.

You can go inside the shop and say you are a customer of “Bubbles Dive Resort”. Do arrive at the shop **at least half an hour** before ferry time.



How to get there?

At Kuala Besut Jetty

Useful numbers:

You will have to pay for the following at the jetty before boarding the ferry, these are the only things you need to pay at the jetty:

Marine Park Fee (Cashless)

- Foreigner - RM30/adult, RM15/child
- Malaysian - RM5/adult, RM2.50/child

Besut District Council Fee

- Foreigner - RM20/adult, RM5/child
- Malaysian - RM5/adult, FOC for child

Balance of payment are due at Bubbles Dive Resort on the island via cash or credit card (visa or mastercard).

Recommended Checklist – What to bring

- ☐ Swimwear
- ☐ Good walking shoes or trainers (if you would like to jungle trek)
- ☐ Sunblock (biodegradable or reef safe preferred)
- ☐ Sandals or flip-flops
- ☐ Reusable water bottle (free refillable drinking water)
- ☐ A hat (to keep off the sun during beach clean)
- ☐ Insect repellent (DEET free)
- ☐ Rashguard to wear in the ocean (if you would like to try diving)
- ☐ Underwater camera (if you have)



Accommodation

- Rooms are all standard air-conditioned deluxe rooms with 2 king size beds
- Attached bathroom with outdoor shower area
- Equipped with eco-friendly 2 in 1 hair shampoo and body shower, hair dryer, bath towels, sarong batik (use as beach towel)



Connectivity on the Island

WiFi is **only available at the reception/restaurant area**, but connection speeds may be slower than in cities.

Many customers enjoy this as **a chance to disconnect and slow down**.

Meals

Below are the meal times for Bubbles:

- Breakfast (American Buffet): 7:30am - 10:00am
- Lunch (Menu of the Day Buffet): 12pm - 2:30pm
- Dinner (Asian Buffet): 7:30pm - 9:30pm

Ala carte orders are not available except for finger food (potato wedges, french fries, nuggets etc.) which are available for purchase between 3pm - 5pm.

Our kitchen will be closed on other timings to prepare for meals. However, drinks and ice creams are available for purchase over the counter from 7:30am to 9:30pm.

You are also welcomed to bring along your own snacks just in case you feel hungry between meals.

If you have any food restriction/allergy, do let us know as well and we will try to accommodate.

Terms & Conditions

- Insurance of any kind is not included in this event, so please make necessary arrangements if needed.
- Once you submit your registration form, you will receive a booking email with a request for RM500 deposit (non-refundable). Deposit payment is required with 24 hours to secure your slot. The final payment can be made at the resort during check out.
- Payment is made to Bubbles Dive Resort, the main host of the event. A portion of the workshop and sponsorship fees will be contributed to Bubbles Turtle Conservation to support its conservation efforts.

Refund & Cancellation policy:

Deposit of RM500/pax is non-refundable.

If full payment is made prior to arrival, cancellation terms below apply:

- 30 days or less before arrival: Non-refundable
- 31 days or more before arrival: 50% refundable (excluding deposit)
